

**Series: Inside God - The Attributes of Our Creator**

**Sermon: God Everywhere! Omnipresence.**

**Bible Verses: Psalm 139:7-12**

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God is \_\_\_\_\_. He is always \_\_\_\_\_. This is an incommunicable attribute of God's (we don't share it).

There is nowhere out of the \_\_\_\_\_ of God.

Psalm 139 says "darkness is as light to you" meaning that even in our \_\_\_\_\_ hiding places God is still present.

### **Comparison Views**

- Pantheism: everything physical \_\_\_\_\_ God, or God is everything that exists.

- Christianity/Theism: everything physical \_\_\_\_\_ by God, God is separate from everything that exists but God is still everywhere.

- Panentheism: everything is inside of God, the world and God are \_\_\_\_\_ upon each other in a sense

- Christianity/Theism: everything is inside of God, God is \_\_\_\_\_ and the world is dependent

### **Implications and Understandings of Omnipresence**

God is present in a \_\_\_\_\_ way in Heaven.
