*Last week fact:* Even though I'm technically a sinner, I am \_\_\_\_\_

Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ for absolute unity and God the Father **hates** those who

Paul says we cannot have divisions that cause us to be distracted from

We should, whenever possible, keep unity as our goal. "Perfectly united in mind and thought"

### **Being in Unity, Practical Application:**
