**Episode 9 Sermon: The Plans for My Life**

**Bible Verses: Proverbs 16:3**

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Proverbs 16:3: Commit to \_\_\_\_\_ whatever you do, and your plans will \_\_\_\_\_.  
(NIV)

What plan/hope/desire should I commit to the Lord, today? \_\_\_\_\_

Reality check: sometimes my plans \_\_\_\_\_.

When we "commit" our plans to God, we \_\_\_\_\_ them into his authority.

**My plans:**

**“ \_\_\_\_\_ THE PLAN,  
DON'T \_\_\_\_\_ THE PLAN.”**

"Your plan" in Hebrew means "your \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ for that plan."

**Revolution Translation of Prov 16:3**

**If I fully roll my goals over to God, because “ \_\_\_\_\_ ” then my  
\_\_\_\_\_ will be successful.**

Practical Application: I must be willing to \_\_\_\_\_, listen while I pray, and find the right thing to do in any circumstance instead of just telling God what \_\_\_\_\_.

Lessons to Learn: I must be willing to trust God implicitly without \_\_\_\_\_ on my part.

Lessons to Learn: I must be \_\_\_\_\_ my plans/\_\_\_\_\_ if God's plan has a different path.

Lessons to Learn: I must believe that God has \_\_\_\_\_ success in mind (unlike my \_\_\_\_\_ solutions).
