**We listen to the \_\_\_\_\_ often.**

King Hezekiah puts out the right voice: he commands everyone to \_\_\_\_\_, and promises that God will show them compassion for their unfaithfulness.

### **PRACTICAL APPLICATION:**

### **The Response**

**Realize:** Hezekiah \_\_\_\_\_ in prayer to God when lies disturbed him. I should too! Instead of getting all distracted by lies they should push me closer to God!
