2. _____ **a foster parent or even adopt a child.** Do the MAPP class: Contact St. Francis (st-francis.org) or TFI (tfifamily.org/) or review adoptkiskids.org. Or contact **Blessed Hope Family** and they'll connect you with the appropriate agency (blessedhopefamily.org)
3. _____ up for them. Tell others the importance or become a court appointed advocate (NationalCASA.org).
4. Provide _____. Give to the church where a portion goes to orphan causes, give to the BIC Spice program (bicus.org/missions/ministry-projects/spice), provide for those who can do foster care or adopt, share in a child's adoption fund (Reece's Rainbow).
5. Find someone who does foster care or adopts and help them: Mow, babysit, organize meals for foster parents. Have a shower for a family adopting a child of any age. Contact the Church office and ask who in our Church adopts and does foster care.
