It is "my" job as a Church member to make these things happen. It is "my" job to accomplish these things. It is not the Pastor's job to do all of this and make the church good and me happy. I am making a covenant with the people here - we will all together do these things as people who are part of this local church.

- 1. I must be an active member of the Healthy Christian Community
- 2. I must pray for the Church regularly
- 3. I must give to the Church regularly and generously

Proverbs 3:9

Honor the Lord with your wealth, with the first-fruits of all your crops;

2 Corinthians 9:6-7

Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously. Each man should give what he has decided in his heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.

Malachi 3:10-11

Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. Test me in this," says the Lord Almighty, "and see if I will not throw open the floodgates of heaven and pour out so much blessing that there will not be room enough to store it.

4. I must support Godly Church leadership

Hebrews 13:17

Obey your leaders and submit to their authority. They keep watch over you as men who must give an account. Obey them so that their work will be a joy, not a burden, for that would be of no advantage to you.

- B. Hospital and Sick visitation
- C. Janitorial Duties

Look at how the Apostle's treated other duties:

Acts 6:1-4

6 In those days when the number of disciples was increasing, the Grecian Jews among them complained against the Hebraic Jews because their widows were being overlooked in the daily distribution of food. 2 So the Twelve gathered all the disciples together and said, "It would not be right for us to neglect the ministry of the word of God in order to wait on tables. 3 Brothers, choose seven men from among you who are known to be full of the Spirit and wisdom. We will turn this responsibility over to...

them 4 and will give our attention to prayer and the ministry of the word."

Ephesians 4:11-13

It was he who gave some to be apostles, some to be prophets, some to be evangelists, and some to be pastors and teachers, 12 to prepare God's people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up 13 until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ.

According to this verse the Pastor's role is:

- 1. To prepare God's people for works of service (primary job)
- 2. To "build up" the body of Christ (via teaching)
- 3. To promote unity among the community
- 4. To teach knowledge about the son of God

Your Responsibility to Pastors and Leaders

1 Corinthians 9:14

The Lord has commanded that those who preach the gospel should receive their living from the gospel.

The context:

1 Corinthians 9:7,11

7 Who serves as a soldier at his own expense? Who plants a vineyard and does not eat of its grapes?


Who tends a flock and does not drink of the milk? ...11 If we have sown spiritual seed among you, is it too much if we reap a material harvest from you?

Paul wrote this and argues that God has commanded preachers of the Bible should be paid by those they preach to. But gives logic to it: if you are a soldier, don't the people who benefit pay for your salary? If you plant a vineyard don't you eat from it?

5. I must help cultivate a spirit of Christian fellowship and oneness within the church If I want this Church to be "one of the most inviting, warm, and gracious places on the planet" then I need to work so that I am "one of the most inviting, warm, and gracious" people on the planet because I am one of the members of this church.

1 Peter 4:9-10

Offer hospitality to one another without grumbling. 10 Each one should use whatever gift he has received to serve others, faithfully administering God's grace in its various forms.






- This is a \$-864.39 deficit.

- Offerings and attendance must go up.












Health of Growth Groups




Areas of Improvement Need More Groups 40 Spots Left









Age Range of Students



High School vs Middle School Students


