

**Series: Mark (Jesus - the Son of God)**

**Sermon: Faith Like a Child**

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**Bible Verses: Mark 10:1-16**

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Yes, children have a sin nature, but they \_\_\_\_\_ have a connection with God.

Parents were bringing their children to Jesus to receive \_\_\_\_\_ from him.

Jesus' command #1: Let the little children \_\_\_\_\_.

*If I see anything that might hinder a child from coming to Christ,  
it's my job to \_\_\_\_\_.*

Jesus' command #2: Do not hinder children \_\_\_\_\_ to Christ.

*I must make sure I don't \_\_\_\_\_ on their way to Christ,  
consciously or subconsciously with the values I pass on, how I talk, and how I live!*

***The Kingdom of God isn't just a "place" and it's not just when Jesus returns to Earth. It's also God's  
spiritual and \_\_\_\_\_ in people's lives \_\_\_\_\_!***

If I do not receive the Kingdom of God like a little child, \_\_\_\_\_ enter it.

### **Receiving the Kingdom of God Like a Little Child**

#1. "Help me!" We must \_\_\_\_\_ for our salvation instead of  
thinking we can work for it.

#2. "I trust you!" I must \_\_\_\_\_, like a child fully trusts their reliable parents.

"Trust in the Lord with all your heart" (Prov 3). The Hebrew word for "heart" is the totality  
of your inner person: What you \_\_\_\_\_, how you \_\_\_\_\_, and what you \_\_\_\_\_.

#3. "I'll Serve!" I must have \_\_\_\_\_ instead of thinking about what's "fair",  
how to be more important, or exerting my rights.

#4. "I'm undivided!" I must be focused on God in the same way as a little child who
