**Main Idea: Bartimaeus didn't care what people thought because he**

\_\_\_\_\_. He was \_\_\_\_\_ than all the objections.

The world's assumption: if something bad happens, God must be \_\_\_\_\_ them.

People assumed blindness was \_\_\_\_\_.

The blind man confessed \_\_\_\_\_, the Messiah they'd all been waiting for!

Nobody wanted to hear him, they found him obtrusive and annoying but \_\_\_\_\_!

The point of Jesus' parable in Luke 18 (the widow) is to **always pray and** \_\_\_\_\_. Similar to the point of the true story of Blind Bart. **Consistence and** \_\_\_\_\_ **Brings God's** \_\_\_\_\_.

When Jesus tells us to "ask God", he uses the Greek word that means, "To ask with \_\_\_\_\_!" It's nearly a \_\_\_\_\_ for something due!" from a lesser person to a greater one.

When Jesus asked, "What do you want?" the blind man \_\_\_\_\_ what he wanted: *to see*.

The blind man was healed completely and immediately. \_\_\_\_\_ healed him!

#### Practical Application:

- When I pray and want God to move in my life \_\_\_\_\_ with him about what I'm asking for.  
*I can't be persistent about something that \_\_\_\_\_,*  
*I NEED A CLEAR GOAL FOR WHAT I'M PRAYING \_\_\_\_\_!*
- The blind man noticed Jesus was with him. Jesus isn't likely to walk by us on the sidewalk, so we need to decide \_\_\_\_\_ we're going to pray, and how we'll do it.
- I gotta \_\_\_\_\_ actually answer. Why did Bartimaeus shout out? He believed if Jesus heard, he *would* answer.
